# **Backgrounder**

## **Operations Committee Meeting**

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### 5.a Post Office Crosswalk

We have another request for a handicap parking area at the post office/clinic. The attached document shows a cross walk with wheel chair access to both sides of the street. Administration recommends that we install this design to the west of the existing handibus spot. We may not need the crosswalk but it would provide an additional spot on the north side of the street.

### 5.b Glass 2U

There is a 6" water main stubbed to the property line on the McNaughton property north of the existing building. The 6" main could be extended west and we may be able to provide water service to the other properties on the interior of the block plan. The lots on the south side of 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave. are likely serviced from 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave.

### 5.e Vadnais Development

We have received requests for water supply to County Developments. Administration is concerned with the request as we are close to the maximum "acre feet" per year that we are allocated.

### 5.h Pow Wow Committee Meeting

A meeting will be held Tuesday, March 11, at 7:30 pm with the POW WOW committee at the Council Chambers. Oliver Shouting has accepted to chair the first meeting so that our committee can get up to speed on POW WOW matters so that the meeting will hum right along.

### 6.d Jim Purnell.

We need to cross his present land to put in the Sewer line to the Agridome and he has some concessions that he would like to see to allow that crossing. The line will go in the new 8 A Ave West when the subdivision is done. Administration will have additional information for committee at the meeting.

6.e Bud Stout

This is on the agenda with the intent that this matter is laid to rest. Bud Stout came into the Town Office wanting to build a 6 foot fence from the front of his house to the front of the property which is outside the bylaw so I think he made that move to protest that Steve Lacusta's fence does not comply.

Greg Ericksen Comments (March 5)

As per your request I have attended Lacusta's residence once again and taken the opportunity to measure his fence as near as I can tell the front post is 41" from the top of his grass to the top of his post and his fence itself is approximately 1.5" below the post which is 39.5". Susan Secretan and I went up there approximately one year ago and informed the planning board of this as it was an issue at that time as well we were told at that time that Steve's fence was fine, so nothing has been done regarding it. Steve's fence is a very nice double sided fence, Buds on the other hand is a eye sore so if something should be done perhaps we should enforce the fact that he should remove his eyesore.
